#### UK foundation funding





Combined annual giving from foundation and lottery sources increased by 50% from the previous four-year period, with foundation giving almost doubling to £204m per year. The overall amounts may still be low given the scale of the challenges but the direction of travel is very encouraging.

#### Mitigation and Adaptation

Mitigation: Action that will reduce man-made climate change. This includes action to reduce greenhouse gas emissions or absorb greenhouse gases in the atmosphere.

 Stop burning fossil fuels
Protect and restore nature
Draw down carbon dioxide from the air)

Adaptation: Action that helps cope with the effects of climate change - for example construction of barriers to protect against rising sea levels, or insulating homes and buildings against extremes of weather.

Build the power of communities affected most by climate change:

- Support their adaptation to the effects of climate change
- Support them to have a voice and lever their influence
